

Again first prize – again Aerosol Deposition: Poster award for Jörg Exner – DKG Annual Meeting 2016

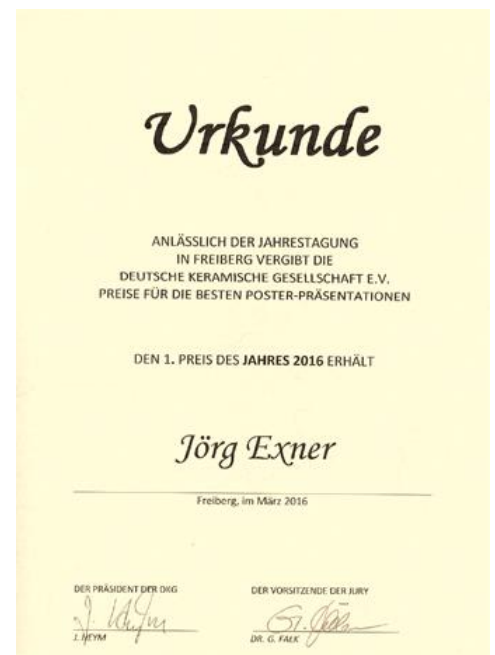

His poster “Tuning the electrical conductivity of Sr(Ti,Fe)O₃ oxygen sensing films by Aerosol Codeposition with Al₂O₃” was co-authored by Michael Schubert, Thomas Stöcker, Dominik Hanft and Ralf Moos, all of the Department of Functional Materials, as well as by Paul Fuierer from New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology in Socorro, New Mexico, USA.
